With contributions of over 150 publications as well as national and international lectures, he has been involved in various teaching and training programs of Trauma Care. He is instrumental in forging collaborations in Trauma Care with countries like USA, Israel, Australia, Japan, etc.

He is presently Professor at the Division of Trauma Surgery and Critical Care, JPN Apex Trauma Centre, AIIMS.
