A Padmashree Awardee, Dr. Subroto Das conceptualised the first EMS in the country over large geographical areas taking his work across the sub-continent, for which he has been honoured globally with an Eisenhower Fellowship and the Asian EMS Award for Lifetime Achievement; and he was elected as an Ashoka Fellow in 2004.
