**What Works and What Does not  
for Road Safety in Developing World**

Kiran K. Kapila, P.E., a Chartered Civil Engineer and a Fellow in the American Society of Civil Engineers is a well accomplished person. Apart from leading a renowned infrastructure Consultancy Organization in India, employing over 1,500 professionals, he is President Emeritus of International Road Federation (IRF) Geneva and Founder President of the IRF's India Chapter.

Mr. Kapila believes that safety in transport network is the hallmark of a sustainable and robust economy – be it road, railways, airports, ports, metros, etc. During his tenure as Chairman of International Road Federation (IRF) from 2010 to May 2019, Mr. Kapila led the organisation towards the vision of "Safe Roads and Safe Mobility" across the World. His focus was to fulfill the UN Decade of Action envisaging 50% reduction in road fatalities through following activities on 5Es, especially in the developing world of Africa and Asia, amongst others. His focus now in the second Decade of Action is to undertake programmes on all the 5Es simultaneously for a visible result and achieving the decadal goals.

Mr. Kapila has authored a number of papers published in various journals and is recipient of a number of national and international awards for infrastructure development and road safety.
