She is a fearless soul, bouncing back from a life threatening accident at 14,000 ft to pursue her passion in just 26 days.

She is an adventurist, and an ardent motorcyclist, a 4 BY 4 Car Driver who has worked on various road safety campaigns. Post her accident in 2019, she decided to take up the cause of Road Safety. She organizes workshops for slum and lesser privileged women and children to educate and create awareness. She is also working as a peer counselor to help accident victims and family members to deal with Post Traumatic Stress Disorder. Apart from that, she does workshops in Educational Institutions & Corporates.

She has been a United Human Rights, Karnataka women president for 4 years and now runs her own foundation, the Pooja Bajaj Foundation who works to further the cause of women empowerment and road safety.
