Dr. Rohit Baluja has a PhD in Civil Engineering from the University of Birmingham. He is now a visiting faculty at the School of Civil Engineering, University of Birmingham. Dr. Baluja established the Institute of Road Traffic Education (IRTE) as a not for profit organisation in New Delhi 1991, which has led to the establishment of the College of Traffic Management, which is now been recognised as the Centre for Excellence in Road Safety for the South East Asian Region. As President IRTE, he is Observer at the United Nations Global Forum for Road Traffic Safety (Working Party 1). The IRTE has been granted the Roster Consultative Status by the United Nations Economic and Social Council. Dr. Baluja is engaged in training police officers, road engineers, judicial officers and transport department officials in traffic management and enforcement, etc.
